Aims of IAPS


- Encourage work in an international context

- Has three votes at the annual general meeting


Local Group




How to become a member?

- •Fill in the form & pay membership fee
 - -Executive Committee will vote on Provisionary status
 - –AGM will vote upon acceptance
- Membership fee
 - -Fee depends on the Gross National Income (GNI)
 - -National Committee: 70 € 350 € a year
 - Local Committees pay 33% of a National Committee
 - -50% discount in the first year possible


